Aumbry Candle

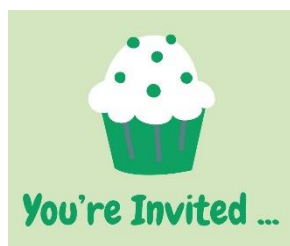

The Altar flowers this week have been kindly donated by Betty Griffin in memory of her close friend Beryl Levie.

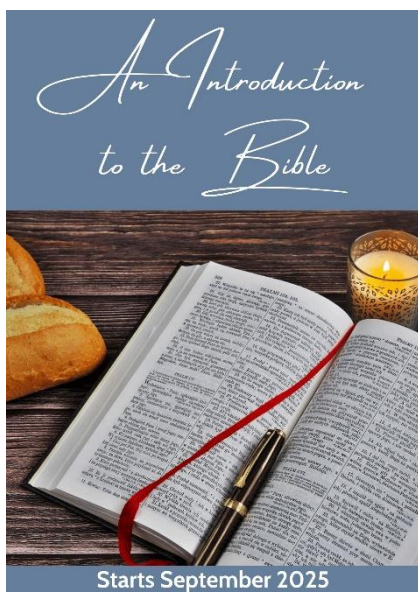
Wednesday Eucharist: On Wednesday 20th August there will be no Wednesday morning Eucharist due to staff holidays.
